What to expect on the day

Registration opens at 08:30am and will run until 09:00am.

The event will be held in the Dave Mackay suite where we will be situated throughout the day. Refreshments and lunch will be served in the room.

You will enter the venue via the main entrance at the front of the stadium; there will be a member of the Network Team in the reception area who will check in your ticket and direct you.

Please be advised, the Dave Mackay suite is located on the top floor and there are at least three sets of stairs to climb, a lift is located on the bottom floor next to the reception area.

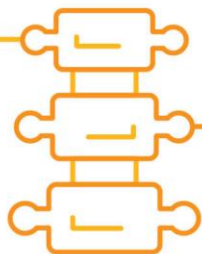
The Network Team can be identified by their tri-colour (orange, green and blue lanyards, they will be available throughout the day for any questions or queries you may have.

Bookable Workshop

We will be running two separate sessions, concurrently in the afternoon:

MRI interpretation of the spine



This breakout talk will be delivered by a consultant radiologist and will focus on MRI interpretation of the lumbar spine. It will include anatomy “what is where”, common findings, report terminology and “what the report looks like”.

Spinal Objective Examination

This breakout talk will be led by a spinal consultant and will cover important objective spinal exam tests for cervical, thoracic and lumbar spine. Including demonstration and group discussion.

Unfortunately, spaces are limited for the MRI session, as a result only 30 tickets have been issued, if you have a ticket booked you will be given a sticker on your name badge upon arrival. For non-ticket holders, you will automatically be enrolled in the Spinal Objective Examination session.

Please be advised that due to constraints with the room layout, we are unable to accommodate non-ticket holders for the MRI session, we apologise in advance for any inconvenience.

Travelling to the venue

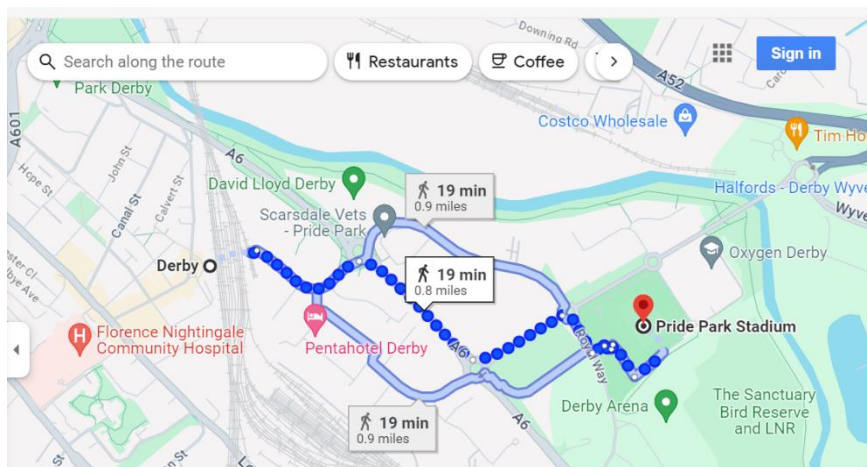
Travel by train

Derby train station is a twenty-minute walk from the stadium; ticket information is available through the link below:

Directions from the train station to the stadium:

- Walk east on Roundhouse Road
- At the roundabout, take the 3rd exit onto Pride Park Way/A6
- At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Derwent Parade
- At the roundabout, take the 3rd exit onto Royal Way
- You have reached Pride Park Stadium

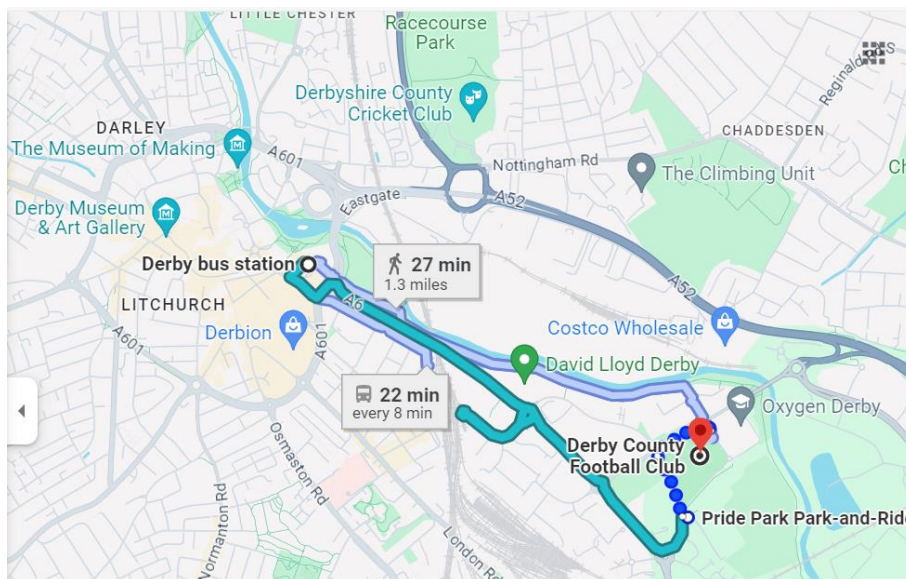


Travel by bus

Parking

Parking outside the front entrance of the venue is free.

The car park behind the stadium (adjoined with the business park) is restricted to two hours.
